

ADVANCED ART III AR4011/AR4012 GRADE 11 -12 FULL YEAR

This course is for art students with talent and/or great interest in further art study. Imagination and quality in art work are emphasized with the recommended high "B" average in art. Projects are assigned with much room for choice and experimentation. A larger sketchbook, art history and some advanced class projects are done. The areas listed in Art II along with individual interests are covered. Students wishing to continue in art studies are guided and given information on schools or vocations available.

PREREQUISITE: Art I & II

CERAMICS AR4050 GRADE 10 - 12 SEMESTER

Students will gain an understanding of, appreciation for, and an ability to create artwork through the medium of ceramics. Ceramics will deal with several areas of clay design and production. Students will devote equal time to hand building (coil, slab, etc.) and wheel thrown methods of forming pots. Pouring molds, glazing, finishing, and organization of materials will be learned.

PREREQUISITE: Art I or art teacher referral

PHOTOGRAPHY AR4060 GRADE 10 - 12 SEMESTER

Students will learn the fundamentals of photographic procedures from the composition of pictures to the developing and processing of film. In addition to the basics, students will experiment with creative photo techniques such as hand-coloring, toning, and working with infrared film.
