

FOUR YEAR COLLEGE ADMISSIONS REQUIREMENTS

The state universities have agreed that to be eligible for regular admission to a four-year degree program, a high school student graduating in 2005 and thereafter must successfully complete the following course requirements:

1. English - four years required
2. Mathematics - three years required, including intermediate algebra; four years strongly recommended.
3. Biological/Physical Sciences - three years required to include one year of biological science and one year of physical science. At least one year of a laboratory course is also strongly recommended.
2. History and Social Sciences - three years required; one year of American history and one year of world history strongly recommended.

Prospective students are also encouraged to complete courses in the following areas;

3. Foreign language - two to three years strongly recommended
4. Fine and performing arts - two years strongly recommended
5. Computer literacy - one year of hands - on- experience in using computers strongly recommended
6. Students need to take the necessary ACT/SAT examinations and contact the college of choice
