

GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

To graduate from Clio High School a student must have:

1. Been enrolled in Clio at least one (1) semester during their final year.
2. Earned a total of 23 credits, 20 of which must be completed in daytime high school requiring regular attendance on campus. Three credits beyond the 20 on campus credits include areas such as correspondence school and adult education courses from a NCA approved educational institution.
3. Earned three and one half (3 ½) credits of English, including one (1) semester from a writing class. Beginning with the class of 2009 a student must have four (4) credits of English, including one (1) semester from a writing class and one (1) semester of English Career Seminar.
4. Earned one (1) credit of Physical Education, or three (3) seasons of Athletics, or three (3) seasons of Marching Band, or a combination of Athletics and Band to total three (3).
5. **Earned two credits of mathematics PROVIDED they have successfully completed Geometry. All other students must have three credits of mathematics.**
6. Earned three (3) credits of Science.
7. Earned three (3) credits in Social Studies, including one (1) year of Freshman Global Studies, one (1) semester of Civics and one (1) semester of Economics for a total of one (1) credit in their sophomore year, and one (1) year of United States History, in their junior year.
8. Earned one half (½) credit of Health.
9. A student must receive a score on the MEAP-HST at the 1, 2, or 3 level or one of the following:
 - State qualifying score for the Michigan Merit Scholarship on the ACT or SAT, and a 1, 2, or 3 on two of the four subject areas required for graduation from Clio High School.
 - State qualifying score for the Michigan Merit Scholarship on Work Keys Test.
 - Must earn an additional ½ credit in a semester course for each category below level 3.

Michigan Merit (MEAP) scholarship requirements exceed Clio High School graduation requirements.

TRANSFER STUDENTS

To graduate from Clio High School, transfer students must comply with the above requirements. However, no transfer student shall be required to enroll in a class which is two or more years behind their current gradeclassification.
